### Meet the Foundation!

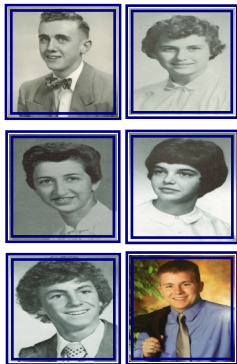

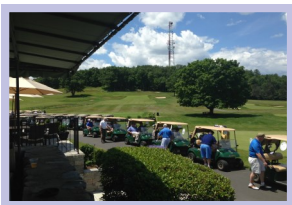

### Foundation Gala Honors Six Distinguished Bernardians.



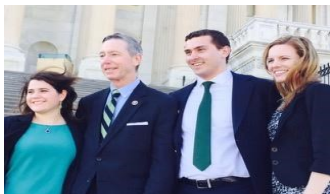
